2020 Order of the Arrow Adult Membership Nomination Form

Completed applications must be submitted to the Scout Service Center by <u>April 15, 2020</u>. Late applications will not be accepted. Incomplete applications will be returned.

Each year, upon holding an election for youth candidates that results in at least one youth candidate being elected, the Unit Committee may nominate registered Unit adults, 21 years of age or older, to the *Lodge Adult Selection Committee* for approval to be candidates for induction. The number of adults nominated can be no more than one-third of the number of youth candidates elected, rounded up where the number of youth candidates is not a multiple of three. In addition to the one-third limit, the Unit Committee may nominate the currently-serving Scoutmaster/Advisor (but not assistants), as long as he or she has served as Scoutmaster/Advisor for at least the previous 12 months.

The Lodge Adult Selection Committee, with the approval of the Scout Executive, will determine adult candidates for induction provided the following conditions are fulfilled:

- 1. Selection of the adult is based on ability to perform the necessary functions to help the Order fulfill its purposes and is not for recognition of tenure or service, including current and prior achievements and positions.
- 2 The individual will be an asset to the Order because of demonstrated abilities that fulfill the purpose of the Order.
- 3. After becoming registered with the Unit, have experienced 15 days and nights of camping during the two-year period prior to nomination. The 15 days and nights must include 1, but no more than 1, long-tern camp consisting of at least 5 consecutive days and nights of overnight camping, approved and under the auspices and standards of the Boy Scouts of America. The balance of the camping (10 nights) must be overnight, weekend or other short term **outdoor** camps of, at most, 3 nights each.
- 4. The adult leader's membership will provide a positive role model for the growth and development of the youth members of the lodge.
- 5. If approved for induction, adults **must agree** to complete 1 of the 2 current year's Ordeal weekend and Ordeal ceremony.

After the meeting of the *Lodge Adult Selection Committee*, all adults will be personally notified. **If selected**, the adult candidate may then register through the Scout Service Center for an Ordeal weekend.

Do <u>not</u> register/pay for an Ordeal before you receive confirmation that your nomination has been approved.
